Section 2.2 God's Story Shared With Us, and Section 2.3 God's Letter to You

1. There are many true stories about men and women in the Bible, but the Bible isn't just a collection of stories. The Bible is THE story, the true story of God. Think of it as God's letter to you. God used people to write the words, but He gave them the words to write. The Bible tell us things about God that we could never know without it. Each true story in the Bible is about God and how He worked in the lives of people. God is the main character in every page of God's story, the Bible.
2. **Genesis 1:1.** What did God do in the very beginning of time? By faith we understand and believe that God made everything that has been made, including people. In the 3rd chapter, the problem of sin entered the world and God's story when Adam and Eve disobeyed God. Sin entered through how many people? What was the result?
3. **Romans 5:12.** Sin created a huge problem for people! Because God is Perfect, He cannot be in the presence of sin. Since we sin, we are separated from God. We can't do anything about our sin, but God had a plan to rescue man from the eternal consequences of sin. God loves us more than we can every possibly imagine.
