This week's verse: Mark 12:30 "Love the Lord you God will all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength."

Section 2.4 God's Instruction to Love Him

- 1. Imagine that you needed to tell someone your age how to get ready for the day. What things would he/she need to do each morning? God loved you so much that He wanted to give YOU something the Bible. The pages and cover of your Bible may get worn the more you read it, but the words He gave you are Perfect. They will never change or wear out. The Bible teaches us to love God.
- 2. Mark 12:28. What question was Jesus asked? A commandment is a rule or law that God wants us to follow. So what is the most important commandment? Mark 12:30. What are the 4 things you are told to love God with?
- 3. The Bible commands you to love God with ALL that you are. Every part of what you feel, what you know, and what you think should love God. It is the most important choice that you can make.
- 4. Loving someone takes work. It is not always easy. Loving God should be something that we think about and put effort into. Imagine for a minute what it would be like if you loved God with everything that you are. What would be different about you? What would stay the same?
- 5. Philippians 1:9. Paul prays that the believers in Philippi would abound (grow) more and more in what?
- 6. Love for God begins with knowing what is in the Bible and learning to understand the truth of Scripture. You can't know God unless you know what the Bible says about Him. When you learn truth from God's Word about His love and His instructions to us, you will want to love God more with your life!
