This week's verse: Romans 8:28 "And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose."

Section 1.5 God is Always at Work

- 1. Your body is at work all the time. It does its job without you thinking about it or telling it what to do. If the parts of your body stopped working together, you would not be able to live.
- 2. Romans 8:28. All things work together for what? God is always at work with His good purposes in mind. He works for His big and good plan. Part of His plan is working all things in life for good. Let's look at a true story in the Bible to understand what this all means. let's read about Joseph in the book of Genesis.
- 3. Genesis 37:28. What was the first thing that happened to Joseph?
- 4. Genesis 39:20-21. After Joseph was accused of doing something he didn't do, what happened to him?
- 5. Genesis 40:23. Joseph helped someone who was in prison with him. What happened when that man got out?
- 6. Genesis 39:21 tells us that even though Joseph was going through hard times, God was faithful and was with Joseph. Toward the end of Joseph's story, Joseph shares his perspective about the hard things he went through.
- 7. Genesis 50:20. Joseph is talking to his brothers here and told them that even though their actions were evil, God meant for it to be good. Just like your heart works in your body to keep you alive, God was working in Joseph's life to work things for good. God used what happened in Joseph's life to save his family and ultimately, the nation of Israel.
- 8. When you are going through something tough, take a moment to remember that God loves you and is always at work, even in the hard times!
