

This week's verse: Mark 10:45 "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many."

## Section 3.2 Jesus Serves

- 1. Mark 10:45. Jesus did not come to have people do things for Him; He came to serve others. The Bible tells us about a time that Jesus showed His love for His disciples by serving them.
- 2. John 13:3-5. What did Jesus do to the disciples' feet? Why was this so significant (important)? In Bible times, people wore sandals everywhere they went. Their feet got very dirty and it was the servants' job to wash them.
- 3. John 13:12-15. What does Jesus tell the disciples to do? It was an unpleasant job to touch the disciples' dirty, smelly feet, but Jesus loved His disciples and wanted to show them His love. Verse 15 tells us that Jesus also did this to give us

  . If we love others, we will serve them like Jesus served His disciples.
- 4. John 13:17. What does Jesus say you are if you do what He did? When we follow Jesus' example, we will have joy because we have obeyed God.
- 5. Read Mark 10:45 again. Jesus came to serve the people He created. He came to give His life and die on the cross so that we could have a relationship with God. We can only have a relationship with God if we accept Jesus as Savior. When we do that, Jesus washes away our sin, just like He washed away the dirt off of the disciples' feet. When we know Jesus as our Savior, we want to love and serve Jesus by loving and serving others.
- 6. Jesus didn't wash the disciples' feet because He had to do it. He did it to show them He loved them. He did it to show us how we should love and serve people. Who in your life can you love and serve this week? What will you do?
