This week’s verse: Luke 22:41-42 “He withdrew about a stone’s throw beyond them, knelt down and prayed. “Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my Will, but yours be done.”

Section 3.3 Jesus Prays

1. When you have a really good or a really bad day, who do you talk to about it? The Bible tells us that while Jesus lived on earth as a man, He prayed often to God. He knew it was important to stop and spend time praying before, after, and during everything He did.
2. How long did Jesus pray? **Luke 6:12**. Prayer is the safe place we can tell God everything good AND bad we are thinking and feeling.
3. When Jesus knew it was almost time for Him to be arrested, He took His disciples with Him to the garden of Gethsemane. How do you think Jesus was feeling knowing what was about to happen? **Matthew 26:37**
4. What did Jesus do about His feelings? **Luke 22:41-42**. Jesus knew He could tell God exactly how He was feeling and thinking. What did He ask God to do for Him (Luke 22:42)?
5. Jesus was fully God and fully man. He knew what was going to happen to Him and how hard and painful it would all be. He also knew that God’s plan was best and wanted to be a part of that plan. What was that plan and what is the Will of God? **John 6:38-40**
6. **Luke 22:43**. What appeared to Jesus and strengthened Him? God sent an angel to give Jesus the strength that He needed. God won’t always send something you can see to help you, but God will always give you the strength you need when you ask Him. We can talk with God when we are having a bad day or have to do something difficult. God will always give you the strength to do what He has asked you to do.
