### Section 3.4 Jesus Sacrifices

1. Have you ever had to give something up for someone else? What did you give up and whom did you give it up for?
2. **Ephesians 5:2.** Jesus gave Himself up as an offering and a \_\_\_\_\_ to God. What does it mean to sacrifice something for someone else?
3. Because Jesus loves us more than we can imagine, He chose to sacrifice Himself for us when He died on the cross in our place. He loves us with the greatest love that has ever been.
4. **Luke 23:33-39.** When they hung Jesus on the cross, who was on either side of Him? What was Jesus' response when He was hung on the cross? Why is this significant? How did most of the people, the soldiers, and one of the criminals treat Jesus when He was hanging on the cross?
5. **Luke 23:44-46.** What did Jesus say before He died? What does this mean?
6. Jesus gave Himself up to God as the sacrifice for our sin. He died in your place so that you can have a relationship with God. DISCUSSION: Why did Jesus need to give Himself up? What would life be like now if He had not died in your place?
7. **Hebrews 10:12.** Jesus is the only one who could have made that sacrifice because He is perfect, and He is God. God wants you to understand that Jesus died in your place for your sin.
