This week's verse: Acts 1:8 "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth."

Section 3.7 Jesus Gives

1. **Acts 1:8.** What did Jesus tell His followers that they would receive when the Holy Spirit came upon them?
2. The disciples had been able to do miracles by the power of God. But Jesus said that they now would have God, the Holy Spirit, LIVING IN THEM! Jesus told His disciples that they were going to be "witnesses." What is a witness? What makes someone a witness isn't that they share feelings or ideas; it's that they share important facts about the truth. God's witnesses tell others the truth about God.
3. The book of Acts tells us how the Holy Spirit filled the disciples and helped them to be God's witnesses. **Acts 4:31.** What were all the believers filled with? How did they speak the word of God?
4. The disciples were told not to tell others about Jesus through their own strength and power. Instead they were filled with the Holy Spirit and given His power to preach the gospel.
5. **Acts 13:49.** Because the disciples were filled with the Holy Spirit and speaking the Word of God boldly, where did the Word of the Lord spread?
6. More and more people heard about Jesus because the Holy Spirit was empowering the disciples.
7. **Acts 13:52.** What were the disciples filled with?
8. **Acts 2:38.** Everyone (you included!!) who accepts Jesus Christ is a believer and has received the Holy Spirit. When we are given the Holy Spirit, we have the power of God in us. This is how we can live in a way that honors Him, loving and serving others. With the power of God, we can be the witnesses He needs us to be. We can tell others the important truth about God's love for them.
