This week's verse: Psalm 9:10 "Those who know Your name will trust in You, for You, Lord, have never forsaken those who seek You."

Section 1.1 God is Trustworthy

1. What does it mean to TRUST someone or something? Have you ever lost trust in someone? Or lost trust in something (like a food doesn't taste the way it always has or a device stopped working the way it always did)?
2. At some point, everything stops being trustworthy - everything except for God! He is the same yesterday, today and will be tomorrow, so we can trust Him completely to be there for us when we need Him. If we trust God and seek Him, He will never forsake us. How do we know this? Where can we find evidence? The BIBLE of course!
3. The true story of David and Goliath shows us that God is trustworthy. Let's read about it.
4. **1 Samuel 17:37-40.** What 2 animals had God protected David from? Whose armor did King Saul want David to wear? Was David able to wear the armor in battle? What did David take instead of the armor? Why did he only take these things?
5. **1 Samuel 17:48-49.** What ended up happening?
6. How was David able to do this? Read **1 Samuel 17:45-47.**
7. Do you think David was scared to fight a man that was over 9 feet tall? Maybe, but David focused on God instead of the giant he was facing. David trusted God because God had been with him and protected him in the past. God had not forsaken him. You will probably never face a 9ft giant that you need to fight, but you will face your own battles. You can always trust that God will be with you.
